Policies and information

Disclaimer:

According to Pa law, you assume the risk of equine activities pursuant to Pennsylvania Law.

What we offer:

LMN offers mentorship sessions, group sessions, and other programs including equine activities but may also include other activities such as picking berries, searching for caterpillars, visiting and helping with other animals as we attain them, as well as service projects we may initiate. Our sessions include biblical scripture and discussion. We do <u>not</u> offer 'therapy' or 'riding lessons'.

Requirements:

The only requirement for attending sessions and programs is that the child wants to come.

What to bring:

- Closed toed shoes or boots are <u>required</u> inside the fence line and round pen that may on occasion get muddy and will definitely get horse poop on them. We do have some donated boots we can lend during sessions, please ask if you would like to use them.
- Water
- Jacket, hat, gloves for cooler temps

Driveway:

The lane to the barn can be wet and muddy, if it is too wet to drive down we will place a block at the top and you will need to walk down to the barn. A surfaced driveway will be installed around June some time, at which time the lane to the barn will be at 118 North School St.

Volunteer Program:

We have a volunteer group of Horse Helpers who are trained to help care for the horses. If you are interested, please visit the Horse Helper page under the Get Involved tab.
